





## **SUPERVISION**

Position reports directly to the Technical Manager and is under his/her general direction.

## **LANGUAGE SKILLS**

Communicates effectively in both oral and written communications. Works as part of a team by contributing to government training goals, offering input and pursuing new ideas.

## **REASONING ABILITY**

Ability to define problems, collaborate with other staff members to meet requirements and to take advantage of opportunities or in the case of shortages, to minimize negative impacts on the training facility. Solves problems when there are no available precedents, guidelines, or policies by drawing upon experience, research, input from peers and other problem-solving alternatives.

## **PHYSICAL DEMANDS**

The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by an employee to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. The position may require lifting 10 to 50 pounds and frequent bending, twisting or reaching.

## **WORK ENVIRONMENT**

While performing the duties of this position, the employee regularly works in an office/warehouse environment with low to moderate noise. Employee may be exposed to weather conditions that are above 100 degrees or below 0 degrees. Wearing of safety clothing may at times be required.

Expect extended working hours, during peak training courses, and evening hours required to support a 2-hour elective course. Prior military experience and training experience is preferred but not required. This position is contingent upon continuation of Federal funding.
